English Teaching Pathways

Applicants who do not meet the required English language level for direct entry can still be made a conditional offer of admission, and are offered a course offer package containing an English language course at UOW College. Located on UOW's main campus, UOW College offers direct entry English language programs without the need to re-sit IELTS or TOEFL, as well as longer-term English for Academic Purposes programs (of up to 48 weeks), IELTS preparation courses (6 or 12 weeks) and an Introduction to Academic Studies (IAS) study skills focused course.
