Welcome to Newcastle University! Starting at university is an exciting time and we realise the importance of finding the right place to live. This brochure details the various options that are available to you.

With over 4,400 rooms, we offer a wide variety of competitively priced catered and self-catered accommodation. Our range of study-bedrooms varies from standard (without washbasin) through to *en suite* and deluxe/premium rooms. The majority of our accommodation is reserved for new first-year undergraduates and postgraduate students.

Our accommodation portfolio includes a number of rooms for students with special requirements, such as mobility or health requirements. We also provide flats for students with partners or dependent children. If you would prefer not to live in University accommodation and like the independence of living in the local community, our NUstudenthomes Property Management Service could be right for you. This unique service offers students a large degree of independence, with the University always on hand to deal with any problems that may arise. Alternatively, we can offer you advice and assistance on finding private-rented accommodation in the city.

You will find all the essential information you need to know about our accommodation and how to apply in the following pages. Make sure you take a close look at our prices on pages 29–30 and also check out the location of our accommodation on the map on the back cover of this brochure.

Accommodation Guarantees

The guarantees ensure that you receive an offer of University-owned or Managed Partnership accommodation for your first year of study. Please note whilst we will try and offer you a room at one of your stated choices, this is not always possible as some sites and room types prove more popular and

are oversubscribed. We will take into account the type of accommodation you prefer and the factors that are most important to you, but in order to house you under the guarantee scheme we may have to disregard your preferences.

The Undergraduate Guarantee

During your first year of study you are guaranteed a place in Universityowned or Managed Partnership accommodation, provided you:

- have accepted our offer of a place at Newcastle as your firm-choice University before 30 June, and
- are coming alone to the University for the full academic year, and
- live in an area from which it would be unreasonable to commute to the University by public transport, and
- have completed the online Accommodation Application by 30 June of your year of entry.

Please note: you must meet ALL of the conditions above and the guarantee may involve some temporary sharing at the start of the academic year. Mature undergraduate students (25+) will be offered accommodation with postgraduate students and should therefore review the postgraduate accommodation in this brochure for the options available when completing the online Accommodation Application.

If you are not covered by the guarantee you are still welcome to apply for a place in University accommodation. If you live within reasonable commuting distance of the University, you should apply in the usual way. Your details will be put on a

waiting list, and students living furthest away from the University will be housed before those living closer to the city centre. If we are unable to offer you a room at the start of term, you will be asked to remain at home until a room becomes available, usually during the first term.

Late, insurance or clearing applicants are not covered by the guarantee. We will endeavour to offer University accommodation but as your application will only be dealt with after all guaranteed students, accommodation will be limited. If we are unable to offer you University accommodation for the start of term, you will be given details of alternative housing.

Newcastle University is very supportive in terms of student support services like the Accommodation Service.

The Postgraduate Guarantee

During your first year of study you are guaranteed a place in Universityowned or Managed Partnership accommodation, provided you:

- are a first-year postgraduate classed as international for fees purposes, and
- are coming alone to the University for the full academic year, and
- have firmly accepted our offer of a place at Newcastle and met all conditions of the offer by 30 June, and
- have completed the online Accommodation Application by 30 June of your year of entry, and
- make an application fee payment of £500, refundable off your summer term's rent, by 30 June.

Please note: you must meet ALL of the conditions above.

We recognise the special difficulties faced by international students coming to Newcastle. Our postgraduate guarantee aims to ensure that you can pre-book accommodation before arriving here and, where possible, we will let you know your accommodation details before you arrive. If you are attending a pre-sessional language course, you will be housed in short-term accommodation by INTO Newcastle University before being moved into your permanent University room. Immigration regulations do not require you to provide a UK address before a visa is issued. If you are having problems getting a visa, refer to the Visa Team website at: www.ncl.ac.uk/students/progress/visa

If you are a **European postgraduate** student, whilst not covered by the guarantee of accommodation, we recommend you complete the online Accommodation Application, including payment of the £500 application fee. We will have a number of rooms available for you. If we are unable to offer you a room, we will make you aware of the alternative options available and refund your application fee in full.

If you are a **UK postgraduate** student, whilst not covered by the guarantee, you can apply for accommodation through NUstudenthomes Property Management Service (see page 25). When completing the online Accommodation Application, vou will be able to check available NUstudenthomes accommodation and make selections based on your preferences. If an offer of accommodation is made, you will be required to pay £200 damage deposit on acceptance. If there is no available accommodation, we can offer you advice and assistance in finding private-rented accommodation elsewhere in the citv.

We have separate sites available for undergraduates and postgraduates, and we also have sites comprising a mix of both. In these, postgraduates and mature undergraduates are placed together (look for the **PG** symbol against the relevant sites).

Application fee: if you cancel your application prior to receiving an offer of accommodation, or reject the offer made to you, we will refund the amount minus a £50 administration fee.

Erasmus/Exchange/Occasional/ Year Abroad Students

The details given below are for both undergraduate and international feepaying postgraduate students following these study paths.

You are guaranteed accommodation provided you:

- will be taking part in a recognised exchange scheme at Newcastle for the full academic year, and
- have firmly accepted our offer of a place at Newcastle and met all conditions of the offer, and
- have completed the online Accommodation Application by 30 June of your year of entry.

If you are only here for part of the academic year (a part-year student), you are not covered by the guarantee. We anticipate we will be able to make you an offer of accommodation, but will not be able to process your application until early September. If we can offer you accommodation, it may be a twin room, shared with a student of the same gender. Second-semester students are more likely to be offered a room than first-semester students.

If there are no rooms available, we can offer advice and assistance on finding private-rented accommodation elsewhere in the city.

Terms of Contract

Undergraduate contracts in University-owned accommodation are for 38 weeks, whilst in Managed Partnership accommodation they are for 42 or 43 weeks. All contracts include the Christmas and Easter vacation periods, which allows you to leave your belongings in your room during the holidays. No meals are provided in catered accommodation during weekends or vacation periods.

For postgraduate students in University-owned accommodation, there will be the option of two contract periods – 38 or 49 weeks. If you choose a 49-week contract, you will be able to stay in your room throughout the year until the end of August 2013. If you have a 38-week contract, it should be possible to extend your stay until the end of August 2013 but there is no guarantee that you will be able to stay in the same room or site.

Arrival will be over Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 September 2012 and you will be advised of the expected contract start date for your allocated room. International and European students will be given contracts commencing 18 September 2012.

When you are offered University-owned accommodation, you will be sent an e-mail that will direct you to the online contract and you will have seven days to respond. If you accept this offer you are electronically signing a legally binding agreement in which you undertake to live in the accommodation for the full period of the contract. There is no notice period in the contract, which means you cannot be released from it. As a resident of University-owned accommodation, you must also observe the terms and conditions for your particular accommodation.

If you are unhappy with your room allocation, we are unable to offer any other alternative. You can, however, after acceptance of your allocated room, register on our facebook page for a room swap. If we can identify another student that wishes to swap with you, we will issue new contracts prior to your arrival. Alternatively, on 1 November you will have the opportunity to request a change of room if you are unhappy with our initial allocation. Swaps and transfers are subject to certain restrictions and fees and cannot be guaranteed.

Should you decide to leave University accommodation, you will be charged the rent on your room for the remainder of the contract and will only be released from this arrangement if another student can be found who is not already living in University accommodation, and who wishes to take over your contract. If you withdraw from your studies at the University you will be charged the rent on your room for the full termly billing period and will only be released if another student can be found who is not already living in University accommodation.

If you are a part-year student and are successful in being offered University accommodation, there is a minimum period of residence. The dates will represent a 'best fit' to match the duration of your stay and you will be charged for the whole period, including vacations. You can only be offered one of the following contract periods, availability permitting:

Managed Partnership Accommodation

This refers to self-catered accommodation in privately owned developments where the University has reserved rooms for students. Contracts offered are over a variety of 42-, 43- or 49-week periods with the possibility to extend over the summer. Due to the length of contracts, this accommodation is not suitable for part-year students. You can move in from September 2012.

If you are offered Managed Partnership accommodation, the room is allocated by University staff but your contract will be with the company who owns the scheme. This means that you will not be able to view and accept the offer online, but it will be e-mailed with other relevant documents. These can be guite large attachments, so you should ensure that your e-mail account can receive them. You will be asked for some payment in advance, such as a deposit and the first payment of rent, to secure the accommodation. If you are unable to provide a suitable guarantor, you may be expected to pay the full-year accommodation fees in advance of your arrival. This is standard practice in private accommodation. You will need to print and return the required documents, and the pre-payment, within the stipulated timescale. The terms of contract will differ to those of the University.

Students living in Managed Partnership accommodation will be liable for the full contract unless a replacement tenant is found. You will not be released from the contract at the end of the termly billing period should you withdraw from your studies.

Rents

We offer a variety of accommodation at affordable rents, providing great value for money and flexible rent payments; you can pay yearly and receive a discount, or pay in termly/monthly instalments by direct debit after you arrive. Rents vary from site to site depending on factors such as distance from the University, type of room, and facilities provided. All rents in this brochure are for the 2012–13 academic year. With the exception of family accommodation, your rent is fully inclusive of all energy and water charges. In family accommodation, energy and water charges are extra. Please see rents given under each accommodation description and the overview on pages 29–30.

FREE Internet*

Internet connection is provided within your accommodation via a hard-wired system. A campus-wide wireless scheme also provides a secure method of accessing the campus network.

FREE Contents Insurance

Personal Possessions Cover comes as part of your accommodation so there are no additional fees to pay unless you wish to top-up your level of cover. Your personal contents are covered whilst you are living in your accommodation and when travelling between University and home. No-smoking Policy

Smoking is not allowed in any part of student accommodation, but is permitted in designated areas of the grounds.

EAT@NEWCASTLE

Wherever you are in the University, you're never too far from somewhere to eat. Whether you need a quick snack on the go, or somewhere warm and inviting to meet with friends, you've got plenty to choose from. Our outlets include the Bistro, Bites, Campus Coffee, Castle Leazes Hub, Courtyard, The Forum, Henderson Hall Bar, Newcastle University Students' Union and Robinson Library Cafe. In each one you'll find a warm and welcoming atmosphere and a team of friendly and dedicated staff. EAT@NEWCASTLE catering outlets across Newcastle University have been awarded the 'Heart of Newcastle' award for our commitment to providing healthy food and drink choices and for our excellent hygiene standards. All of our outlets provide at least one vegetarian option at all times and we offer a selection of Halal sandwiches at the Bistro in the King's Road Centre.

Students with Special Requirements

If you have a specific requirement for a particular type of room or location for reasons relating to a medical condition, disability or other circumstances, you may be given special consideration when we allocate you a place in accommodation. You must complete the relevant part of the online Accommodation Application, and you will be required to provide additional supporting medical evidence to ensure that you are provided with the most appropriate accommodation or equipment. For example, if you have a hearing impairment you may require special equipment in order to be alerted to a fire alarm. Some other possible facilities include:

- wheelchair access
- additional space for specialist equipment
- a mini-cool fridge to store medication

You are advised to contact the Accommodation Service as soon as possible for advice on which type of accommodation best suits your requirements. If possible, you should visit us to discuss your needs and to ensure you are happy with the facilities. Student Wellbeing can help you make arrangements for your visit. Accommodation for Couples and Families

The University has a variety of accommodation available for students who are bringing partners and families. While couple accommodation is not guaranteed, you are still encouraged to apply as we have around 45 self-contained studios and flats specifically for couples without children, and a further 21 double rooms with either *en suite* or shared bathroom and shared kitchen facilities. Please refer to the Accommodation Fees information on pages 29–30, which provides an overview of options for couples.

If you have children, you are advised not to bring your family to Newcastle until you have been able to arrange suitable accommodation for them. The University has a limited number of flats for families with children. These are mainly at Bowsden Court, but we also have a few units of family accommodation on campus. If you are sent an offer of accommodation, you must keep the Accommodation Service informed of any changes in your travel plans prior to your arrival at the University. Demand for family accommodation is high and we cannot guarantee availability. Please note that our family accommodation is only suitable for single parents or couples with one to three children. We are unable to provide accommodation for extended family such as grandparents, other relatives, or hired help.

If you have not received written confirmation of an offer of family accommodation before leaving home, we strongly advise you not to bring your family with you.

If we are unable to offer you University family accommodation, you will need to consider looking for private-sector accommodation on arrival. We strongly encourage you to view all accommodation before committing to a property. For advice on finding private accommodation, visit our website at:

The Student Accommodation Code



Following The Housing Act 2004, Newcastle University is registered to The Student Accommodation Code which has been developed by Universities UK and Guild HE.

The Code protects students' rights to safe, good-quality accommodation, wherever they are studying and makes sure they get the best out of their time living in university residences. Bedding Packs

Undergraduates will need to provide their own bedding. To save space when packing, if your room is in University-owned accommodation, you can pre-order a bedding pack (pillow, pillowcase, duvet, cover and sheet) at a price of $\mathfrak{L}25$. Students living in Managed Partnership accommodation will need to provide their own bedding.



Student Sport

At Newcastle we believe that your time spent at University can be enriched by competitive, recreational and social sporting activities.

The Centre for Physical Recreation and Sport in conjunction with the Athletic Union offers an exciting range of sporting opportunities. Our extensive portfolio of sports facilities, wide range of sports programmes and over 55 sports clubs ensures that there is something for everyone – whatever your ability.

Student sport is one of Newcastle's enduring strengths. In 2010–11 our British University and College Sport (BUCS) ranking was 15th. We have won many national university sports championships and students from Newcastle have represented their country in a wide range of sports.

Equally important is the fact that large numbers of Newcastle students take part in sport through our campus sport programme, consisting of intramural (inter-hall/inter-department) sports leagues, exercise classes and fitness services, as well as occasional use of our sports facilities. These all help students to maintain a healthy lifestyle, try new activities and make new friends.

Silver Level Sports Membership (Undergraduate Students Only)

As an undergraduate resident of University accommodation, a discounted Silver level membership of the Sports Centre is added to your accommodation package. This membership is valid for three years and covers the period 24 September 2012 to 30 September 2015. This membership fee of £156 is in addition to your accommodation fees and will be charged directly to your account when you take up your offer of accommodation at the University. Please note that the membership fee will be added to your first term's payment or split across three direct debit payments.

Postgraduate students should visit our website **www.ncl.ac.uk/sport** or contact the Sports Centre on 0191 222 7474 for further details of Sports Centre membership.

Silver level sports membership entitles holders to: book and take part in casual activities free of charge at the Sports Centre, eg badminton, squash, five-aside football, basketball; take part in the intramural sport and exercise class programmes; and if you are a member of an Athletic Union club, to take part in club matches and training sessions.

Upgrading your Sports Centre Membership

If you wish to have unlimited access to the 120-station Health and Fitness Suite and free exercise classes at the Sports Centre, you will be required to upgrade your Silver level membership to Gold level on an annual basis. The upgrade charge for 2012–13 is £105 (valid to 30 September 2013).

Opting Out of Sports Centre Membership

If you are certain that you will not take part in sport during your time at Newcastle you must opt-out of the Sports Centre membership scheme when taking up your offer of accommodation at the University. If after arriving at Newcastle you decide that you are not going to take part in sport, you have until 8 October 2012 to cancel your Sports Centre membership by completing an online cancellation form available at: www.ncl.ac.uk/sport/membership/cancellation

The Benefits of University Accommodation

There are many advantages to choosing University-owned and Managed Partnership accommodation:

- The student experience in our accommodation, students have the opportunity to meet people from diverse cultural and social backgrounds. Friends made in your first year at University often remain friends for life.
- There's an extensive range of facilities at different sites.
 You have a choice of catered or self catered, and en suite,
 washbasin or standard rooms.
- In case of emergencies, we always have someone on call, even out-of-hours – on some sites this could be from the team of wardens and senior residents, at other sites it could be University security or a night porter.

- We have a transparent pricing structure inclusive of most fees, making it easier to budget. We offer flexible payment terms to help you spread the cost. Single student accommodation fees include energy (up to a set fee in Managed Partnership accommodation) and water charges.
 Internet connection and contents insurance are both FREE!
- As your landlord, the University takes its responsibilities seriously, endeavouring to provide a comfortable living environment favourable to both study and relaxation.
- Continuous contracts contracts cover the full academic year and include the Christmas and Easter vacation periods so there is no need to empty your room when you head back home for short visits.
- You have the option to extend your stay over the summer vacation, so if you need to remain in the city for employment purposes, or want to stay to visit local attractions, we can offer you a room during this period.



Types of University Accommodation

The following pages provide details about each accommodation site to help you choose the right one for you. One of the main decisions when choosing accommodation may be whether you prefer catered or self catered. You will need to refer to our symbol key (opposite), which gives a quick view of what is on offer.

Catered Accommodation

- The catered package includes breakfast and evening meals on weekdays during termtime. Meals are not provided during vacation periods and this is reflected in the rent. All food is freshly prepared on site with healthy and indulgent options clearly signposted. This makes budgeting easier and means fewer trips to the supermarket, and no washing up! You still have small kitchens for the preparation of drinks and light meals.
- Bath and shower facilities are provided, on a shared basis, with students of the same gender.
- Catered accommodation offers a range of facilities such as shops, computer clusters, bars, music rooms, laundrettes, table tennis rooms, snooker rooms and car parking.
- You can just move in and get on with University life. Each accommodation site organises lively social events to help new students make friends.
- There are wardens and senior residents living in the accommodation who provide welfare support, helping to create an environment within which you can relax as well as study.

Please note: catered accommodation can meet most dietary requirements but not all, so if you are specific about the food you like to eat you may prefer our self-catered accommodation. We are unable to offer Kosher, Vegan or Halal diets.

Self-catered Accommodation

- Accommodation in flats is arranged as a number of studybedrooms sharing a central kitchen, common room, and bath and/or shower facilities. Some rooms offer en suite facilities.
 A small number of the self-catered sites offer larger communal areas where groups of students can gather together.
- Self-catered rooms within Castle Leazes and Henderson Hall centre on a corridor with communal kitchen and bathroom facilities for the same gender group or have en suite facilities.
- Cookers, microwaves, refrigerators and freezers, ironing boards, vacuum cleaners, kettles and toasters are all included in the accommodation, as well as kitchen packs which include crockery, cutlery and cooking utensils. A small cleaning pack will be supplied on your arrival.
- Sites offer a partial cleaning service, covering communal areas only. You are responsible for cleaning your own study-bedroom.
- You can cook your own meals when you want or eat at one of the various EAT@NEWCASTLE outlets on campus.
- Rooms are normally allocated to students of similar age and academic status; every effort is made to allocate new undergraduate students in the same part of each site. This helps students make a large number of friends very quickly, developing a strong feeling of community.
- A 24-hour security team provides out-of-hours support in case of emergencies.

What We Offer

We offer a selection of different room types, so check which type best suits your requirements from the options below:

Study Bedroom

Study bedrooms comprise a bed, desk, chair, wardrobe and shelving with Internet connection* included as standard. You may bring your own television but you are required to obtain your own television licence and you should be aware that viewing TV via a PC, laptop or tablet also requires a television licence.

Standard Facilities (No Washbasin)

These rooms provide a bedroom with no private wash facilities but share these (ie washbasin, shower and toilet) with fellow residents. The ratio of facilities to residents is available in our Summary of Sites available at www.ncl.ac.uk/accommodation/students/apply/ consider.htm. Fees for a standard room are less than those with an en suite or washbasin.

Washbasin Facilities


These bedrooms include the addition of a private washbasin whilst other facilities (ie shower and toilet) are shared with fellow residents. The ratio of facilities to residents is available in our Summary of Sites available at www.ncl.ac.uk/accommodation/students/apply/ consider.htm. Fees for a washbasin room are less than those with en suite facilities but more than those with standard facilities.

En Suite Facilities

Rooms offering en suite facilities provide an adjoining pod bathroom, comprising a private shower, washbasin and toilet, which is for the sole use of the occupant and guests.

Bowsden Court is a modern purpose-built site offering a range of attractive and affordable accommodation which will appeal to a wide variety of students, no matter what your age or level of study. The site is situated two miles from campus and has excellent links to Newcastle's shops, restaurants and bars via the Metro transport system. There are numerous local shops, pubs and food outlets as well as a large supermarket close by.

Accommodation on offer includes:

A selection of five- and six-bedroom flats with single en suite rooms and shared kitchen/lounge areas which are ideal for first-year undergraduate students making new friends. All flats have undergone recent refurbishment and offer stylish refrigerators, comfortable sofas and include a flat-screen TV complete with Freeview and TV licence.

For **families**, we offer a selection of two- and three-bedroom flats for students with dependent children. The flats are fully furnished with the addition of a washing machine. In the lounge, there are



telephone points and Sky (subject to subscription) and Freeview TV connection but students must provide their own TV and licence.

For the more mature **postgraduate**, we have 11 two-bedroom flats which offer large rooms on a single occupancy basis. There is a separate fully furnished lounge, kitchen and a bathroom that includes a bath and shower. In the lounge, there are telephone points and Sky (subject to subscription) and Freeview TV connection but students must provide their own TV and licence.

Castle Court is a modern, purpose-built development located in the heart of the Castle Leazes site. There are two room sizes to choose from - a standard single, and a spacious deluxe with a larger bed – both offering en suite.

Each flat provides seven bedrooms and a fully equipped communal kitchen offering American-style fridges and a large range oven, in addition to a lounge/dining area with comfortable sofas where you can relax at the end of a hard day. A flat-screen TV is also included in each communal area complete with TV licence, so that's one less thing to worry about!

This accommodation has the added benefit of access to the social and communal facilities at Castle Leazes as well as the option of buying into the catered package (see page 24 for more information).

Castle Leazes is within a short walk of the campus, University Sports Centre and city centre. It provides comfortable accommodation with a vibrant and friendly atmosphere, offering both catered and self-catered options.

For those in catered rooms, breakfast and evening meals are served Monday to Friday in the dining rooms. You will need to provide your UCAS or Postgraduate ID number along with some personal information about yourself to enable you to create a login. You will also need to create a password, which should be something you will easily remember. You will be sent an e-mail in order to validate your e-mail address, which you must do before completing any part of the application. You should note that coming from a web-based system the e-mail may be redirected into a 'iunk folder' or identified as 'SPAM' so you are advised to remove any junk filters that you may have set up on your e-mail account. You should use an e-mail address that you can access at all times, especially during the summer months as this is when we will contact you with regards to your accommodation. A school or agent's e-mail address is therefore not recommended.

You must complete all stages of the online Accommodation Application. Your responses determine which accommodation you will be allocated. You are asked to list two different types of accommodation and to rank a maximum of three of your named preferences under each type. You should be aware that some residences are very popular and often oversubscribed.

Please note, these are preferences only and you should not regard them as a guarantee of that particular site/room. We will try to meet your requests; however, it is not always possible to do so. If there are no vacancies in any of your named preferences, we will attempt to house you in accommodation with similar facilities to those you have selected, based on the availability of rooms on the day of allocation. When to Apply

You should complete the online Accommodation Application as soon as you have been made an offer to study at the University (this can be a conditional or unconditional offer, your firm or insurance choice) and those covered by the guarantee should aim to do this before 30 June 2012.

Undergraduate students holding an Insurance Offer should apply upon receipt of your offer to study at the University, but are not guaranteed accommodation. If you attend Newcastle under the Insurance scheme, we will consider your application after all guaranteed students have been allocated a room. Clearing applicants will be sent accommodation literature as soon as you accept an offer to study at Newcastle through the Clearing system. Other applicants not covered by the guarantee are strongly advised to complete the online Accommodation Application as soon as possible and you will be placed on a waiting list for University-owned or Managed Partnership accommodation.

What Happens Next?

You will be allocated your room as soon as you have met the terms of your academic offer and your application will be dealt with based on the date you applied. You will be informed as early as possible about the outcome of your application. All applicants covered by the guarantee can expect to receive an offer of accommodation as follows:

Undergraduates including Full-year Erasmus/Exchange Students

- If you are holding an Unconditional Firm offer, you should hear from us before the end of April.
- If you have a Conditional Firm offer dependent on exam results, you will receive an offer of accommodation within two weeks of receiving your results, providing your offer has been confirmed and the University has received your online Accommodation Application.

When you have completed the online Accommodation Application, paid the $\mathfrak{L}500$ application fee and accepted the unconditional offer to study at Newcastle University (all of which must be done before 30 June 2012), we will process your application.

Your offer of accommodation will not be sent before the end of April 2012. We allocate postgraduate accommodation throughout the year, but we are particularly busy in August and September. If you have not received an offer from us by the first week in September, please contact us by completing a web enquiry form, available at: www.ncl.ac.uk/enquiries

All Students

While every effort will be made to offer you a place in the type of accommodation you prefer, this cannot be guaranteed. We will assess the suitability of the available accommodation for your particular needs when considering your application. If you fail to disclose this information, it could result in you being made an offer of unsuitable accommodation with an appropriate alternative no longer being available.

Offer of Accommodation

The offer of accommodation will be sent to you by e-mail. It is important therefore that you check your e-mails regularly over the time period stated earlier, but especially during the summer period, including your junk folders. If you are not able to do so you should ensure that someone else, a parent or guardian for example, can check on your behalf. If you have been offered a room in University accommodation, the e-mail will direct you to the Application Homepage where you will need to log-in to your My Details section with your Applicant number and password.

From the My Details page you will see a link to allow you to view the offer of accommodation and you accept or reject the offer online. **Please note:** you must ensure you accept or reject the offer within **seven days** of receiving the e-mail. Failure to respond to the offer within the required timescale will result in the offer being cancelled and the room offered to another student. We may not be able to make you a further offer.

You should also be aware that in making an initial offer of accommodation to you, we have fulfilled our guarantee to you. It is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** on receipt of that offer to respond as instructed.


