By foot or on bicycle

Whiteknights campus from Reading station:

Approximately 1.6 miles, around 35 minutes by foot

- With the station behind you, turn towards the statue of Edward VII and proceed into Station Road
- At the crossroads, turn left into Friar Street towards the old Town Hall
- Bear right into Market Place, with the Post Office on your left, follow the road past Lloyds Bank
- ▶ At the junction with **Kings Road**, cross over into **Duke Street**, crossing the canal with the Oracle centre on your right
- ▶ Proceed straight into **London Street**, following signs for **UoR**
- Turn first left into London Road, then first right into Kendrick Road
- ▶ At the top of the hill, turn left into **Christchurch Road**
- ▶ At traffic lights follow the main road into **Shinfield Road**
- ► University entrance on your left

Earley Gate entrance from Earley station:

Approximately 0.8 miles, around 15 minutes by foot

- ▶ Bear left on **Station Road**
- ► Turn right onto **Wokingham Road** (A329)
- ► Turn left onto **Wilderness Road** (B3350)
- ► Turn right onto Whiteknights Road

Bulmershe campus from Earley station:


Approximately 1.5 miles, around 28 minutes by foot

- ▶ Bear left on **Station Road**
- ► Turn right onto **Wokingham Road** (A329)
- ► Turn right onto **Church Road** (B3350)
- ► Turn right onto Woodlands Avenue

London Road campus from Reading station:

Approximately 0.7 miles, around 15 minutes by foot

- ► Follow the instructions for Whiteknights Campus until **London Road**, then:
- Take second exit on the right into Crown Place, the University entrance is signposted



By bus

Fares are currently £1.70 single, £3.50 return. No change given.

By car

From the west, east and south:

- ► Travel to **Junction 11** of the M4
- At the exit roundabout, **take the B3270** signposted to Earley and the University of Reading (UoR)
- ► At the traffic lights, stay in the left hand lane and turn left onto the A327 (Shinfield Road)
- ▶ Follow the map (left) showing University entrances

From the north:

- ► Travel towards the **town centre**
- Join inner distribution road (marked IDR on map), follow signs to the University of Reading (UoR)
- Just after a major junction with a right turning to the A33, take the left exit, signposted to the University of Reading (UoR)
- ► Travel along London Street and Silver Street
- At the top of the hill, turn left at the roundabout onto the A327 (Christchurch Road)
- ► Follow the large map (left) showing University entrances




