Beginner to Advanced Plus

Coursebook concept

The coursebook contains 15 units and each student will purchase a kit which consists of 1 Course Book, 1 Workbook and 1 Audio CD. Each unit has one unifying topic, and is made up of the following:

After every Course Book there is an Achievement Test to assess the learner's progress.

Elective Courses — iELECT

Monday to Friday 2:00pm – 3:30pm

The After School and Weekend Language Electives and Workshops are selected, organized and offered at Inlingua Victoria to enhance and enrich each of our student's learning while at the same time addressing the more difficult areas of English Language Acquisition. Electives are offered Monday to Friday from 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm and Saturday from 10am –12pm. A monthly schedule will be posted showing the rotation of the electives and the classroom numbers assigned for the electives. The electives are less structured than the regular classes in the mornings and afternoons; however, the additional class time per day is a real value and contributor to our student's English Success at Inlingua Victoria. Inlingua iOnline Learning

iOL includes an extensive range of varied exercises and reference materials and is designed to help with the acquisition of vocabulary, the development of speaking and listening skills, increasing grammatical understanding, and exercising the functional language. It is a blended learning tool which merges the benefits of both classroom and internet learning.

Inlingua Grammar Say it Right

This elective will help you to improve your grammar structures that you are learning in your regular English Language Communication Program

Pronunciation, Fluency and Accuracy

In this elective through the use of exercises focused on listening and repetition, students learn various sounds and understand various cross-cultural linguistic differences that exist, and practice correcting any problematic speech patterns that exist.

Reading and Writing Skills

This elective will help you to improve your grammar, vocabulary and TOEFL score while at the same time enjoying a variety of English literature. During this seminar we focus on group discussion and reading strategies.

English for Work

This elective will include a study of face-to-face communication on the job, including development of interpersonal skills, meeting management, interviewing and presentational speaking.

Current Affairs and Pop Culture

In this elective students examine how English is used in film and TV and what is happening in the world with this media and the how the changes affect us. Students will watch great films and TV programs and engage in interesting and controversial discussions

Intercultural Communication

This elective provides an introduction to communication between people from different cultures. The topics and activities are designed to develop communication skills that improve competence in intercultural situations.

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On the first day of arrival students will take a written and oral placement test to determine which Inlingua Level of English. English for Academic Purposes

This elective will help improve your reading comprehensive and academic writing skills. Primary focus will be on vocabulary and grammar structure taken from a variety of academic tests such as SAT, TOEFL, and IELTS.

Leadership Project

This elective introduces communication skills in task-oriented small groups and includes focus on planning, participating in, and leading meetings; decision-making and problem-solving methods; forms of discussion; and social dimensions. Small group projects will be implemented.

Effective Listening for Accuracy

In this elective students will work at improving their overall English listening skills by listening for specific information, expressions and vocabulary, while listening to music.

Semi-Private Lessons

This elective program is for the student who has time pressures or has specific work or academic needs, or wants to supplement their morning and afternoon classes with a more personalized approach to learning. Days and times can be arranged at the time of your application

Slang and Idioms

In this elective students examine the use of idioms and slang and learn about the informal side of English. The elective looks at slang phrasing, intonation and colloquial vocabulary building. Students also share their experience of expressions that they have heard or know.

Saturday Conversation Workshop

In this workshop students will participate with other students as well as TESL students and our instructors, and spend time discussing a variety of topics Saturday morning. This workshop is a fun way to gain confidence and improve your conversation skills.
