Applicants are urged to apply for college accommodation before receiving an offer from The University. It is essential that applications are submitted earlier rather than later and preferably before 30 September (see below).

When you have completed the attached Application Form, send it to the College you have indicated as your first choice. Your application must include two passport sized photographs of yourself and a non-refundable application fee of \$50.00 (includes GST) for students living in Western Australia, or \$60.00 (includes GST) for students living interstate or overseas.

CLOSING DATES: APPLICANTS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO SUBMIT THEIR APPLICATIONS BY 30 SEPTEMBER FOR ADMISSION IN SEMESTER ONE (BEGINNING IN FEBRUARY), OR BY 30 APRIL FOR ADMISSION IN SEMESTER TWO (BEGINNING IN JULY). APPLICATIONS WILL STILL BE ACCEPTED AND WELCOMED AFTER THIS DATE, THOUGH SPACES ARE LIMITED.

RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA

There are five residential Colleges affiliated with The University of Western Australia. Four of the Colleges are co-residential with St Catherine's College offering accommodation to female students only. Some Colleges have Church affiliations but all applications are considered irrespective of religious or cultural background. All Colleges strive to create an environment in which students of different ages, interests and backgrounds are able to live together in a supportive community.

The Colleges are in parkland settings immediately across the road from The University of Western Australia's Crawley campus. They are located ten minutes from the main Perth CBD and fifteen minutes from the beach. All Colleges offer fully-catered accommodation, with residents having their own furnished study bedroom, within a caring and secure environment.

Academic support, through formal tutorials and individual help, assists students make a smooth transition to the Australian academic system. The Colleges offer support to all students in the development of sound study and time management skills to ensure the best academic outcome for each resident, while also encouraging residents to become involved in the many activities that are a part of college life.

Each of the Colleges has a Residents' Club and Committee which organise a wide variety of social, cultural, sporting and other activities to encourage all residents to participate in the college community. There is a very active sporting competition between the Colleges, with the Nicholson Cup for men and the Women's Inter College Sports Association (WICSA) for women.

Applying for residency?

A single, common application form for the Colleges is opposite. Send the completed form, with the appropriate application fee, to the College of your first choice. Send the form as soon as possible; do not wait for a formal offer from the UWA Study Abroad Office or university confirmation of enrolment. Applicants are encouraged to maintain contact with the College of their first choice.
