At-a-glance

The LLB(Hons) two-year Law degree has all the advantages of the three-year degree LLB(Hons) Law with the additional benefit of graduating a year earlier.

Until May of the first year, this course is identical to the three-year degree, but students enrolled on this route will continue their studies through June, July and August. This is achieved by an innovative combination of face-to-face teaching and distance learning with a strong focus on employability and skills.

In June of the first year, there is a period of intensive teaching from 9.30am to 5pm every day for a two-week period. A further 60 credits are taught over the summer and you will develop the skills needed to engage with the distance-learning aspects of the course.

Final results are published in the September, allowing successful graduates to continue their studies onto our highly-regarded Legal Practice Course or onto our taught LLM programme which allows specialisation in a variety of areas.

In addition to your studies, you can opt to take part in numerous competitions such as mooting, interviewing and negotiation, all skills important in the workplace.
