These are ideal for students who have completed their High School education and wish to gain a place at a leading UK university.

For students who wish to study Medicine and Dentistry, our Medical Foundation Programmes offer a unique range of pathways, enhancing opportunities of gaining a place at a UK university and also create routes to Medical and Dental schools in other EU countries.

Lastly, our Pre-Masters Programme helps graduates from overseas to gain entry into Masters Degrees in all subjects at highly ranked universities.

For those whose first language is not English, we have English language classes which can be taken on their own, or as preparation for one of our other courses.

GCSE Courses

Our GCSE Programme is for students who have completed Year 9 and are intending to progress on to our A Level studies, University Foundation or Medical Foundation Programmes. It can be taken over one or two years and helps to provide a solid grounding for later studies.

Teaching takes place in small groups ensuring that all students receive individual attention. Each student is given a personal tutor who supervises academic progress and ensures that all aspects of student welfare are looked after.

Students are helped to develop academic skills to ensure a smooth transition onto their next programmes, and English language support is also provided to help achieve the necessary IELTS requirement.

We are very conscious of the challenges for young students living apart from family and friends, and every effort is made to foster a supportive and friendly environment.

AS & A Level Courses



A Levels are the standard route in the UK to university. Students can choose to study over one or two years. In the two year route, students take four subjects in their first year (A/S Level) and three subjects in the second year (A2 Level). On the one year programme, students take three subjects. It is also possible to study over eighteen months, starting in lanuary.

Teaching takes place in small groups with a maximum of eight students per class – normally there are four or five. This allows all to benefit from individual care and attention from the tutor, and to avoid suffering in silence if there is any part of the course which is not fully understood.

All our A Level teachers have many years of experience and understand exactly what is required to gain high grades. With places at top universities becoming increasingly competitive this is an essential ingredient of success.

In the last two years Abbey College students have gained places at many prestigious universities including LSE, UCL, King's College, Manchester and Bath.

All A Level students receive free English language and study skills support throughout the programme.

Abbey College is an examination centre for all A level examining boards.

Our Foundation Programmes are one year full time courses, and has been devised in consultation with UK universities to provide the best possible preparation for a degree course.

In the first term, students are given tuition in Mathematics and IT, as well as courses to improve communication skills and to prepare for the British Council IELTS examination — an essential qualification for university entry. Also, students are taught various study skills which they will require at university. These include essay planning, referencing and research skills.

In the second and third terms, students choose the Foundation Programme which best suits their chosen subjects at university. There are four options:

- Business and Management
- ICT
- Engineering
- Law and Social Sciences

All students are given individual help in choosing suitable degree courses and universities. You will receive advice in completing your application form for universities, completing a personal statement, and preparing for interviews.

M&D Medical Foundation Programme

The programme helps students to acquire the knowledge base and academic skills necessary to study Medicine at degree level. It provides an understanding of how the human body works through the study of physiology, genetics and molecular biology, cells and tissues, microbiology and chemistry.

Successful students have a guaranteed progression on to the M&D Pre-Medical programme in London. This is also a one year programme and is validated by the University of Buckingham. The Pre-Med has an excellent record of securing students places at UK Medical Schools and also offers opportunities to gain places at Medical, Dental and Veterinary Science Schools both within and outside the European Union – all courses are taught and assessed in English. Students on the M&D Medical Foundation can also progress directly on to degrees in Pharmacy and other life sciences at UK universities.

Pre-Masters Programme



The Pre-Masters is a one year full time course intended for overseas students who wish to progress to a Masters Degree at UK universities.

It has been designed to equip students with the necessary language and study skills to gain entry onto a Masters programme in the UK. The transition from undergraduate to postgraduate level study is often difficult and challenging, and this programme helps to ensure that this transition is made successfully.

Our Pre-Masters is suitable for all subject areas. Each student will receive individual mentoring appropriate to their chosen field of study as well as one-to-one assistance in the application process for a Masters in the UK. It is a strongly skills based programme.

English Language Courses





Abbey College in London has a range of general and more specialist English Language courses which can be taken separately or as part of a combined programme.

We have a dynamic team of experienced and well-qualified teachers who are all native English speakers and who understand the particular requirements of international students. At the start of the course, you will be given an assessment test and placed in a class at the right level. Your progress will be closely monitored throughout the programme, and as your English improves, you may be moved into more advanced groups. At the end of the programme, you will be given a report and a certificate to say that you have completed the course. For General English students, it is also possible to take the City & Guilds International ESOL exam with us, giving you an internationally recognised qualification

When you arrive, you will be given lots of information which will help to make your stay in London easier and more enjoyable. We are a small and friendly college, and there are always plenty of teachers and other staff to help you. Teaching takes place in small groups which means that tutors can focus more easily on the specific needs of individual students. It is also possible to combine group lessons with one-to-one sessions.

Accommodation

Different students have different requirements, and we ensure that everybody finds a place to live which is most appropriate to their individual needs. Abbey College in London will give you all possible help in finding the right place.

TYPES OF ACCOMMODATION

Shared Student Apartments Cost £80 - £140 per week.

This is the most popular form of accommodation where four to six students share a flat and prepare their own meals. We work with an organisation which specialises in finding comfortable student flats at a reasonable price. Please ask us for further details.

Homestay

Cost £140 - £235 per week.

Students live with a family in Zone 2 or 3. The family will either prepare meals or allow you to use the kitchen facilities. This type of accommodation provides a secure environment particularly suitable for younger students, and helps them to practise their English as part of the family. Again, we work with an organisation that specialises in finding suitable families. All homestays are carefully inspected and monitored.

Student Hostels

Cost: £100 - £240 per week.

Hostels will usually provide some meals or will provide shared cooking facilities. All our hostels are in Zones 1, 2 or 3. Those nearer the centre of London tend to be more expensive but offer excellent en suite accommodation. Hostels in Zones 2 and 3 cost less and still offer very comfortable accommodation.


Bloomsbury Square is within easy walking distance of three stations - Holborn (Central and Piccadilly Lines), Tottenham Court Road (Nothern and Central Lines), and Russell Square (Piccadilly Line).

From Holborn Station, it is about a five minute walk to Abbey College. Turn right out of station along Southampton Row, turn left along Vernon Place, and then turn right and walk across Bloomsbury Square. Abbey College in London is situated on the corner of Bloomsbury Square and Bedford Place.

Abbey College in London is situated in the heart of the capital in the famous Bloomsbury Square - the oldest square in London dating from the seventeenth century.

We are within easy walking distance of the West End with its many theatres, shops, restaurants, and historical attractions. The British Museum is just a two minute walk away from the college. From our central London position, we have excellent public transport links. Holborn Underground station is five minutes away, and from here, trains go directly to North, East, and West London. There is also a direct train link to Heathrow Airport.



Student Progress and Welfare

We strongly believe that students can only achieve their potential in a supportive environment. Through regular assessments, we are always aware of how each student is progressing in their studies, and are able to quickly identify areas which may need additional attention. We encourage everybody to take responsibility for their own development and reinforce this with support and advice.

We like students to play an active role in the running of the College. On arrival, you will be invited to join our Student Union. The Union helps to arrange trips to places of interest within and outisde London, organises student events, and also provides feedback to our staff on all aspects of College life.

Parents and guardians receive reports twice per term and are always welcome to come and visit us and talk with the teachers.

Studying in the UK and living in London is an exciting and unforgettable experience, but it does also present challenges, and we do everything possible to help students to feel happy and secure in their new lives. From the day students arrive at the airport, we are there to give support in finding suitable accommodation, helping them to open bank accounts and get student discounts on public transport, and ensuring that any problems which arise up are dealt with swiftly.
