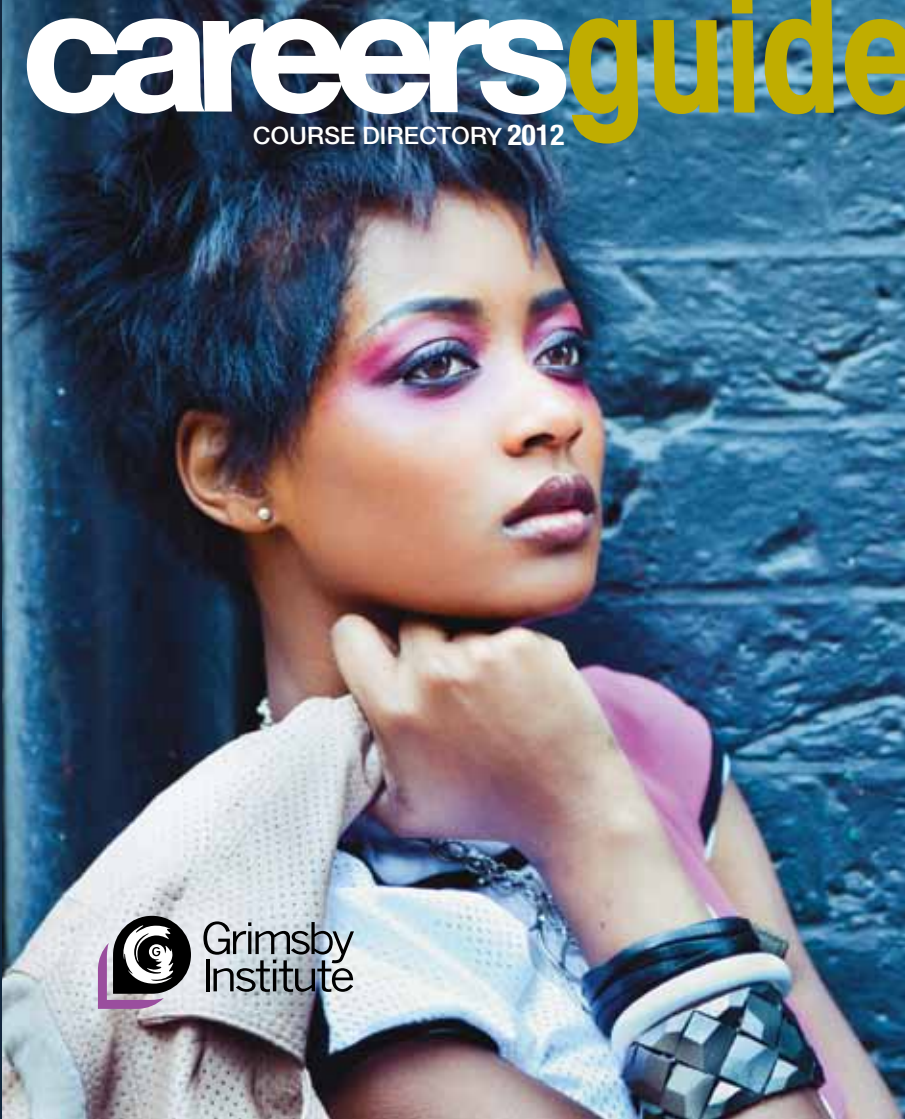

We are really proud that our learners can experience realistic working environments and have access to modern facilities and industry standard resources.

You will not only study and gain recognised qualifications you will also gain and develop personal skills which are highly valued by employers. We also recognise the importance that employers place on good standards in English, Maths and ICT so we make these part of your Individual Learning Plan. ## Full-Time Study

It goes without saying that it's very important you choose the right course for you and we're here to help you do just that. We offer a range of different Further Education routes from Entry Level through to Level 3, depending on ability, qualifications and your chosen subject area.

## Entry & Level 1 Courses

These may not need GCSEs, although we encourage you to always try and get the best grades possible. These courses usually last for one year full-time and can be studied alongside a GCSE.

## Level 2 Courses

These usually require two-four GCSEs Grade D or above and tend to last for one year of full-time study.

## Level 3 Courses

A course at this level normally requires four-five GCSEs Grade C or above and will usually ask for both Mathematics & English. These courses usually last for two years of full-time study.

## Apprenticeships

A fantastic way of earning cash while you gain a qualification. Apprenticeships are typically taken over two years, working four days each week in your chosen career while attending the Grimsby Institute for one day to study.

## GCSE Retakes

Don't forget you can retake any GCSE qualifications while studying something different at the same time.

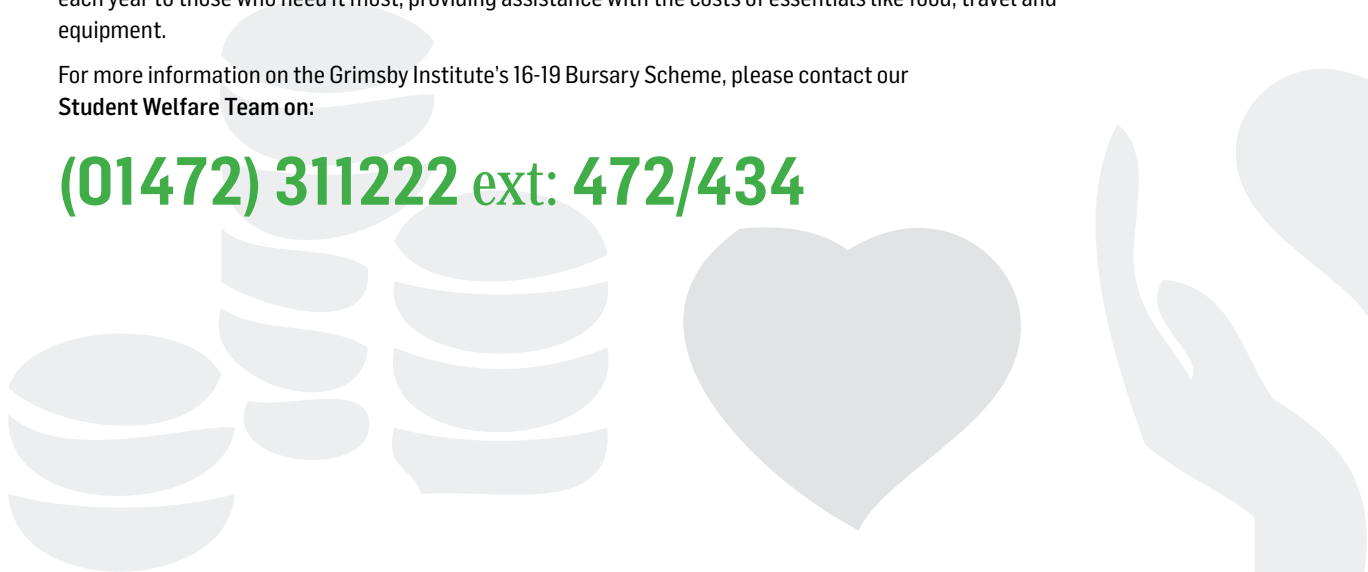
## 16-19 Bursary Scheme

In order for Alasdair to become a full-time **teacher** he decided to **re-take** some of the GCSEs that he’d missed out on at school, studying them **alongside** the **FdSc**, as Alasdair explained:

“I’ve been diagnosed with **Dyslexia**, and everyone at the Institute has been **really helpful**, they’re really always there to give their support.”



## RACHEL SAID:

“I want to become a Solicitor and I’m going to be studying a Solicitors Exemption Degree and the tutors have taught me really useful things like how to study independently, which is going to be essential when I go to University.”

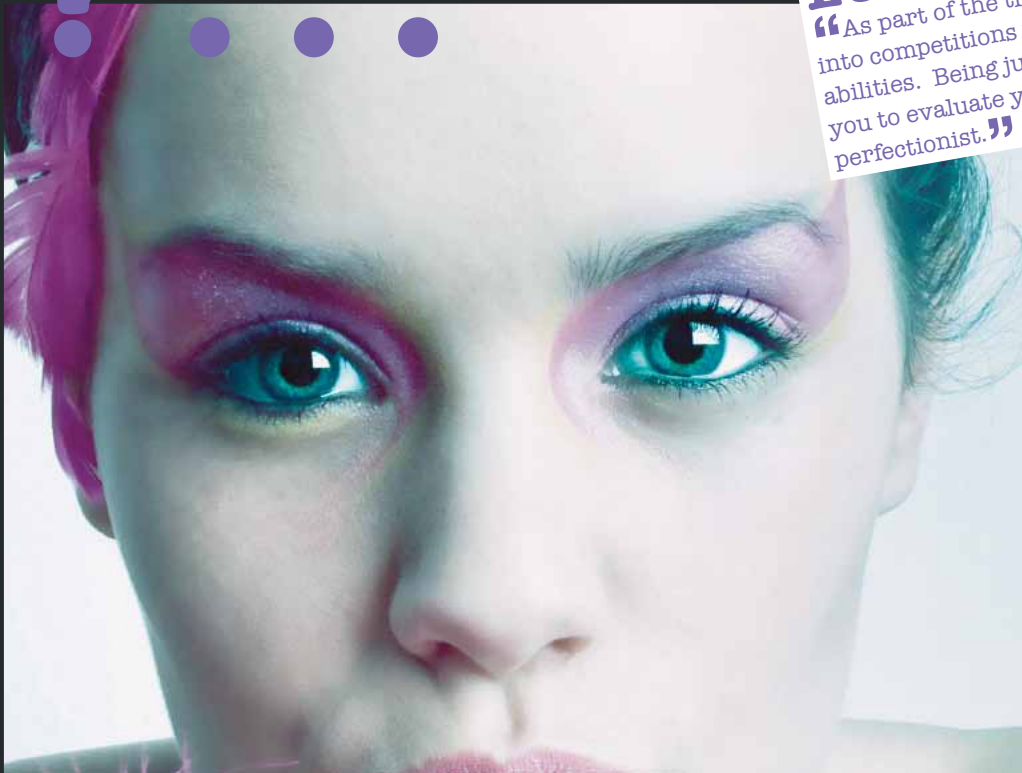

# Sustainability

## within the Grimsby Institute Group

**The past year has brought many changes to the Grimsby Institute Group, one of which is a determination to become more actively sustainable within our daily practice, both across the institutional space and within our curriculum.**

February 2012 will see our first Green Week – an ideal opportunity for staff and learners to unite in finding fun and innovative ways to engage with sustainable development – looking at the environment, our local community and the wider economy and its impact upon our society.

Our new buildings, including the University Centre Grimsby have been constructed to BREEAM very good rating, which is great news for our drive towards carbon reduction within the Institute. The new sports hall, due to be built in 2012, will be built to the same exacting standards. The long-term master plan for our existing buildings will include measures to actively improve energy consumption and reduce waste, as will our move towards a predominantly paper-free environment. Our campus at Yorkshire Coast College has just had a new, more-environmentally friendly boiler installed so that we can cut down on emissions and reduce fuel bills.



Our Estates Department are constantly looking to introduce energy saving schemes, some of these include the introduction of passive infra red switches on our lighting circuits, recently we introduced the new powerPerfector technology onto our incoming power supply, this alone reduces our energy consumption by about 13%, which saves a projected annual carbon dioxide savings 222,300kg.

We are putting in place a green traffic plan and we are cutting vehicle emissions by reducing the size of our fleet. In addition to this we actively encourage vehicle sharing when travelling between our many sites. We also use video conferencing extensively across the Group to cut down on the amount of travelling between campuses too. All of these measures demonstrate our commitment towards the aim to actively promote environmental awareness within the Group.

There's more to come in the new academic year too where as part of our Learner Engagement Strategy we will offer learners, for the first time, the opportunity to be actively involved in assisting our Sustainability Working Group in their move towards creating a new Sustainable Development Strategy for the Group.

At the Grimsby Institute Group, we take our responsibility to our local community and to the planet as a whole very seriously, and this new Strategy will offer a whole Group approach to leading by example, raising awareness and actively communicating good practice. The Strategy will be annually reviewed and updated in order to ensure that Grimsby Institute Group is setting a leading example in terms of achieving pro-sustainable behaviour in all that we do.

## Driving from the North & West

Approach Grimsby via the A180, turning off at the junction sign-posted Great Coates. Continue over two roundabouts following signs for Great Coates and Grimsby and then turn left at a third roundabout. Proceed through a set of traffic lights after which there is a church on the left-hand side. At the next roundabout, with "The Trawl" Public House opposite, take the right-hand lane and turn right into Little Coates Road.

At the first mini-roundabout, turn left into Cambridge Road. Continue to a second mini-roundabout and proceed directly across. On the right-hand side is the Grimsby Institute's Art & Design Centre. For the Nuns Corner site continue long Westward Ho to a set of traffic lights. Turn right into Bargate, staying in the right-hand lane. After approximately three hundred yards, and immediately before a further set of traffic lights, turn right into the Grimsby Institute's main entrance.

## By Car

Driving to Grimsby is easy with our great connections to the UK motorway network.

## Driving from the South and Lincoln













Approaching via the A46. After Caistor a roundabout is approached. Continue straight across this roundabout following the signs for Grimsby. Proceed directly over a second roundabout, with a Morrisons Supermarket on the left-hand side and then over a third roundabout, continuing to follow the signs for Grimsby. Continue along Laceby Road until the road divides in two, taking the left-hand lane.

The turning for Grimsby Institute is on the left-hand side.
